While we were "away", we have kept up the good work of the foundation where and when we can. Over the last three years, we have donated more than \$4,500 to educational organizations and scholarships, including:

- \$3,000 to Oklahoma Youth Symphony Orchestra
- \$500 to Oklahoma Children's Theater
- \$500 to San Francisco Public Schools
- \$500 to San Francisco Youth Symphony

We have also welcomed a new board member, Matt Shelton. Matt was a friend of Sarah's and the Koss' since high school and brings a wealth of corporate experience to the board. We're excited for his contributions to come.

In 2024, we're looking forward to getting back into regular rhythm. First, we will continue the music scholarships and education donations that we have done since our inception, which now includes the Oklahoma Youth Orchestra, the San Francisco Community Music Center, and the San Francisco Youth Orchestra. These allow us to give the gift of music to curious students and let them view the world through harmony that we feel prepares them for the world in unique ways.

Second, we're planning to have our second (kinda-)annual Let Your Imagination Run! We really enjoyed seeing the costumes that everyone brought to our first organized race and are looking forward to making it even bigger and better this time. We plan to hold the run in <u>San Francisco in the July 2024 timeframe</u>.

Lastly, we're resuming our in person education events. We have deeply missed seeing kids run through parks as they explore the adventures that we've created. In Fall 2024, we will resume our in person education events in Washington D.C. with a new program called "Rocket to the Stars." We hope to bring it to other locations in 2025.
